Dear Parents,

Our Summer School program is getting ready to kick off another exciting three-week session from June 4th - 22nd. All students currently enrolled in grades 4K – 8th grade are encouraged to enroll!

There are some big changes to Summer School this year. Instead of students signing up for 4 different courses, students will now be exposed to approximately 12 different courses! They will have academics (STEM and Literacy) and fun mixed in daily. Due to the change in the structure of the summer school program, there will be no need to select classes. You will simply register for summer school and all of your old favorites and lots of new experiences will be built in. Also, since we will not be collecting fees for individual courses, we will be collecting a \$12 fee from every student in grades 5K-7th. That's less than a dollar per day for some of the most fun and educational experiences your child will have this summer. Students registering for the week long 4K Fun & Learning will have a \$2 fee.

If you are interested, swimming will still be offered during the first hour of summer school for students currently in grades 1st-7th. There is a \$35 fee for swimming. Sign up for it when you register!

“Snack Bags” will be available through our food service program during summer school again this year for 5K-7th grade. You need to sign up for this option when you register for summer school. The snacks will be delivered to your child on a daily basis.
